Multiplying Good Announces Inaugural Class of ChangeMakers in the Twin Cities

St. Paul, MN – Multiplying Good Minnesota's goal is to cultivate the next generation of servant leaders in the Twin Cities. The organization is pleased to announce the inaugural Class of ChangeMakers in the Twin Cities—community leaders who have demonstrated a commitment to service and the potential to truly move our community forward.

The 2024 Twin Cities ChangeMakers class kicks off with an orientation and networking event on *January 25th*, 2024 at 1 pm at Paikka in Saint Paul with a happy hour following at Lake *Monster Brewing*. Throughout the winter and spring, ChangeMakers will work both individually and as a cohort to raise financial support for Students In Action, Multiplying Good's flagship youth leadership development program that uses service-learning to prepare students for success in high school, college, and beyond.

Each month, the ChangeMakers will participate in volunteer, leadership development, networking, fundraising, and recognition activities that both celebrate them as ambassadors for service-learning while raising awareness of Students In Action and its impact throughout the Metro. The program will culminate in May 2024 with a celebration event recognizing each ChangeMaker with a Jefferson Award and celebrating the difference they have made across our Greater Twin Cities communities.

Nationally, the Jefferson Award is the country's most prestigious honor for service and volunteerism, and honorees—individuals including such notable figures as Barbara Bush, Oprah Winfrey,

Peyton Manning, Justice Sonia Sotomayor, and many others—make up a storied group of American heroes whose dedication to service has inspired others to lead.
